

Society Bookings 2011

If you have already booked a provisional date with us for your society visit, I would appreciate you returning the society booking form, together with a deposit cheque of £100 (non – refundable) within 14 days, this will then secure the society booking in our diary.

Charges for the day

Our society package is based on a minimum of 10 visitors. In the event of your final numbers falling below this criterion, you will be billed for a minimum of 10 visitors.

The current charges for green fees and catering are set out on the society booking form. You may choose the format for your day from these options and all requests, menu choices, times etc should be indicated on your booking form. Any member of your society who is also a member of the Dyke Golf Club will not be charged a green fee. However, County Cards and the usual arrangement whereby a member of the Dyke can introduce a guest at reduced rates are not permitted in a society booking.

The office must be advised of final numbers for golf and catering at least 72 hours before the day of your visit. Your account will be submitted in accordance with this final figure but subject to a minimum of 10 visitors. Approximate numbers should be inserted when completing your booking form but any sizeable difference in numbers should be notified as soon as known so that you or tee reservation can be amended accordingly. If there is a sizeable increase in numbers and this is not notified to the office within 7 days of your visit, we can not guarantee an increase in your pre-booked tee reservation. Accounts must be settled on the day unless otherwise pre-arranged with the General Manager. We would appreciate accounts being settled either in the Office before play commences.

On arrival

- Society organisers must report to the Professional Shop on arrival.
- Societies must provide the Professional with a list of starting times and names of players and supporters (this for locker room security also).
- On receipt of this information the society organiser will be given scorecards. The Professional will also give the pin number, will allow access to the changing rooms.
- Society organiser to be responsible for observance of starting times including any re-arrangements required by the Professional.

- Times will be allocated based on numbers and format notified. The tee booking system is set up with alternating 7 and 8 minute intervals.
- Societies will be allowed 2 hours to complete their first nine holes (1 ¾ hours for singles). If longer is taken society must accept that it must alternate with any other matches starting at the turn.
- If the allocated starting time is delayed by such weather and travelling difficulties, the Club will do its best to alleviate inconvenience but some must be expected if members are waiting to play.

Catering

Please note that when selecting your menu, only a single choice of dish is available as it is not possible for us to cater for different menus in one sitting. A vegetarian menu or additional meals for non-golfers can be catered for provided they are booked in advance. If you require any other catering, please advise the office who will be happy to quote for other menus.

Dress and Course Etiquette

Please see document for dress code and etiquette on the course and in the clubhouse. Could you please ensure that all your members are aware and fully observe these regulations?

All societies must play from yellow tees (except Ladies who play from the red tees).
